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2184. TEXTBOOK ADOPTION – ELEMENTARY MUSIC

The Superintendent recommends approval for Elementary (K-5) Music Textbook Adoption.

Elementary Music Grades K-5	\$132,600	Quaver's Beyond Marvelous WV K-5 General Music Curriculum with 6 year license 17 digital teacher licenses

Upon discussion and input from classroom teachers throughout the district, the purchase of the 6 year adoption of *Quaver's Beyond Marvelous WV K-5 General Music Curriculum* is recommended. Teachers who work in multiple schools or are hired as Central Office/multi school will be able to bring their license with them from school to school. There is no cost for the student digital licenses.

Estimated Textbook Expenditure: \$132,600

2185. RENEWAL OF DATA TRANSMISSION LINE SERVICES

The Superintendent recommends approval for the renewal of data line transmission services for all Cabell County Schools and non-instructional facilities. Frontier, Inc. was the winner of this three-year contract which must be renewed annually. Monthly prices are \$2,702 for 2 GB, \$1,351 for 1 GB, \$960 for 100 MB, and \$418 for 10 MB. This is the first renewal of this contract and the rates are the same as last year. The estimated annual cost will be \$319,000.

2186. RENEWAL OF TELEPHONE SERVICES CONTRACT

The Superintendent recommends approval for the renewal of Centrex and Primary Rate ISDN telephone services for all Cabell County Schools and non-instructional facilities. Frontier, Inc. was the winner of this three-year contract which must be renewed annually. This is the first renewal of this contract and the rates are the same as last year. The estimated annual cost will be \$185,000.
