Minutes of August 1, 2017 (Regular Meeting) are being presented for approval.

2023. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of Huntington High School's trip request for the Golf team to travel to Wheeling, WV, on August 2-3, 2017, to participate in a golf tournament. No school will be missed and four (4) students along with one (1) chaperone will be on this trip. Transportation will be provided by the parents. Expenses will be paid from school funds.

2024. INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS AND EL EDUCATION

The Superintendent recommends approval of two cooperation agreements between Cabell County Schools and EL Education not to exceed \$141,000. EL Education will provide a package of services to the faculty and school leaders of Explorer Academy and to Huntington East Middle School. At Explorer Academy, this package includes twenty-eight (28) days of on-site professional development, off-site professional development for teachers and school leaders, as well as technical assistance to foster full implementation of expeditionary learning, the school improvement model for Explorer Academy. At Huntington East Middle School, the package includes strategic planning days for the school's leadership team, off-site professional development for teachers and school leaders, and twenty-two (22) days of on-site coaching to assist in the implementation of the EL Literacy Modules implementation in grades 6-8. The implementation of the EL Literacy Modules are part of the school improvement model for Huntington East Middle School.
