2166. <u>MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE, COUNTY EXTENSION SERVICE COMMITTEE, AND CABELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION</u>

The Superintendent recommends that the Board of Education continue this memorandum of agreement at the current appropriation of \$13,000 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016.

2167. CHANGE ORDER #001 FOR HUNTINGTON HIGH SCHOOL – CIMCO, INC.

The Superintendent recommends approval of change order #001 in the amount of \$12,430.00 for Huntington High School's cooling towers with Cimco, Inc. The purpose of this change order is to provide all labor, material and equipment necessary to change piping connections to the towers from 4" to 6". Funding source is Local.

2168. <u>CHANGE ORDER #018 FOR CULLODEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL – WISEMAN CONSTRUCTION</u> COMPANY, INC.

The Superintendent recommends approval of change order #018 in the amount of \$29,029.00 for the Culloden Elementary Project with Wiseman Construction Company, Inc. The purpose of this change order is to provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to upgrade the existing fire alarm, hookup kitchen equipment, relocate kitchen roof drain and relocate existing chiller flow switch. Funding source is Contingency.

2169. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – CABELL MIDLAND HIGH SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of Cabell Midland High School's trip request for four (4) students to travel to Morgantown, WV, to participate in a Culinary Competition. The date of this trip will be March 1-3, 2016. Pro Start along with two (2) chaperones, Steve Martin & Becky DeHart, will be on the trip. Three (3) days of school will be missed and transportation will be provided by a rental car. Expenses will be paid from school funds.
