2201. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – HUNTINGTON MIDDLE SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of Huntington Middle School’s trip request for fifty (50) students involved in the Western Virginia Military Academy/Lizzie Cabell Finishing Club to travel to Barboursville, WV, to attend the Civil War Reenactment. The date of this trip will be May 13-15, 2016.
