2030. CHANGE ORDER #001 FOR BARBOURSVILLE MIDDLE SCHOOL – DAN HILL CONSTRUCTION

2034. INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS AND EL EDUCATION

The Superintendent recommends approval of two cooperation agreements between Cabell County Schools and EL Education not to exceed \$75,200. EL Education will provide a package of services to the faculty and school leaders of Explorer Academy and to Huntington East Middle School. At Explorer Academy, this package includes twenty (20) days of on-site professional development, off-site professional development for teachers and school leaders, as well as technical assistance to foster full implementation of expeditionary learning, the school improvement model for Explorer Academy. At Huntington East Middle School, the package includes strategic planning days for the school’s leadership team, off-site professional development for teachers and school leaders, and twelve (12) days of on-site coaching to assist in the implementation of the EL Literacy Modules implementation in grades 6-8. The implementation of the EL Literacy Modules are part of the school improvement model for Huntington East Middle School.

The Superintendent recommends approval of an interagency agreement with Cammack Children’s Center to provide 2017-2018 Title I Part D program resources to support the education of neglected and delinquent students at the CCC on-ground school. (\$ 39,000.00)

2036. INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS SPECIAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND CAMMACK CHILDREN’S CENTER

The Superintendent recommends approval of an interagency agreement with Cammack Children’s Center to provide resources to deliver a free appropriate public education to students with disabilities eligible under IDEA and Section 504 at the CCC on-ground school. (\$ 30,000.00)
